- Class 25 **Pre Novice Ridden.** Open to Pure Bred, Part Bred & Anglo Arab stallions, mares and geldings 4 years. Not to have been placed 1st to 3rd in any affiliated ridden showing class and will NOT be ridden by the judge. May NOT also enter classes 19 to 24 or 31 to 33.
- Class 26* **Small Riding Horse** - Not to exceed 15.2h.h. Pure, Anglo & Part Bred stallions, mares & geldings, aged 4 years & over. To be judged on all round suitability as a riding horse. Will not be required to jump.
- Class 27* **Large Riding Horse** -Exceeding 15.2h.h. As class 25
- Class 28* **Amateur Riders** Open to Pure Bred, Part Bred & Anglo Arab mares and geldings. The rider does not need to be the owner of the horse/pony but must not have received any remuneration for showing or training horses. The rider should not have been placed first or second with the horse/pony in any ridden class at an AHS affiliated show prior to 31st December 2009.
- Class 29* **Young Riders:** Ridden Pure, Anglo or Part Bred Arab mare or gelding age 4 years old and over suitable to be ridden by a rider up the age of 21 years on 1st January 2010. To be judged as a riding horse/pony. A special rosette for the best rider 16 years and under on the day of the show.
- Class 30* **Ridden Veterans:** Pure Bred, Part Bred or Anglo Arab aged 15 years & over. To be judged on condition and performance as a riding horse/pony.

SHOW RULES AND CONDITIONS

SPRING SHOW 2010

- 1) This show is affiliated to The Arab Horse Society and will be subject to the current Show Rules and Regulations of the Arab Horse Society.
- 2) Objections under AHS Rules must be made in writing and submitted to the Show Secretary within one hour of the end of the class or the occurrence and accompanied by the a deposit of £50.00 (fifty pounds). For further details, please refer to the AHS Rules for Showing.
- 3) All exhibits must be registered with the AHS in the appropriate section by the closing date of entries.

A COPY OF THE AHS REGISTRATION DOCUMENT MUST BE ENCLOSED WITH ALL ENTRY FORMS.

- 4) Entries with a postmark of after 25th March 2010 will only be accepted if the class is NOT full and if accompanied by a Late Entry Fee of £5.00 per class i.e. £15.00 per class for SEAHG members and £19.00 per class for non SEAHG members. Late entries may not appear in the show catalogue.
- 5) The Show Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.
- 6) The Show Committee may at their discretion, cancel, split or amalgamate any class/es.
- 7) (spare)
- 8) All perpetual challenge trophies **MUST** be returned to the Show Secretary at least one month prior to the following years show. Failure to do so may result in the exhibitor not being permitted to exhibit at future shows. Non members may be required to leave a deposit before removing a trophy.
- 9) No entry fees will be refunded unless a class is cancelled or on production of a valid Veterinary Certificate.
- 10) The judge's decision in all cases will be final. He/she may withhold any award if there is not sufficient merit.
- 11) The Show Committee reserves the right to arrange for replacement or substitute judge if necessary.
- 12) All communication by any exhibitor to a judge must be via the appropriate steward.
- 13) No horse or rider may leave the ring without first obtaining the permission of the judge.
- 14) Any horse behaving in a dangerous manner may be asked to leave the showground.
- 15) All stallions and colts aged 3 years and over must be bitted and wear secure bridles.
- 16) All handlers are asked to wear traditional English dress.
- 17) No claim for anything that may happen to onlookers, exhibitors, owners, agents, their servants, horses or property, in connection with, or arising out of this show, or conduct or management thereof, will be recognised. Further, exhibitors must indemnify the Show Committee against all actions, costs, claims, demands or liability arising out of any action in which he or she may be concerned.
- 18) No person shall be mounted on the showground unless he/she is wearing a correctly fitting hard hat.
- 19) Unattended horses and ponies must not be left tied to the outside of any vehicle.
- 20) Anyone noticing an incident of neglect or ill treatment must report this to the Show Secretary /Steward immediately.
- 21) All dogs on the showground must be kept under control on a lead at all times.
- 22) All horses/ponies entered in any ridden class must be aged four years and over.
- 23) A novice horse is one that has not been placed 1st 3 times (prior to the start of the current season) and has never qualified for HOYS. Horses competing in the UK for their first season under saddle are only deemed a novice if they have not been ridden in open classes abroad.
- 24) In the event of the Show having to be cancelled The South East Arabian Horse Group reserve the right to withhold 25% of entry fees paid to cover expenses.
- 25) An exhibitor whose cheque for entry fees etc. fail to clear when presented for payment will be required to pay all outstanding Monies and any incurred charges before being allowed to compete. The Show Committee reserves the right to refuse future show entries from that exhibitor.
- 26) Stabling will be available from 5 p.m. on Friday 23rd April 2010 until the end of the show for a fee of £35.00 per box (inc. VAT). This fee includes a £5.00 "Clean Box" deposit which will be refunded upon inspection when the stable is vacated. Refunds will only be made on the Showground on the day of the Show. Stables are only considered booked upon payment of the full booking fee and may be booked by completing the appropriate section of the entry form.
- 27) An exhibitor of any horse occupying a stable without prior booking will be required to vacate the stable immediately leaving it in a clean condition. The Show Committee reserves the right to refuse show entries from an exhibitor whose horse is stabled without prior booking or is in an incorrect stable. A plan of the stable area and occupants will be lodged with the Show Secretary.
- 28) Class times will only be given for the first class of each section/session, and exhibitors will be notified of any changes following receipt of entries. Classes will not start before these times unless all entries are present. Competitors are strongly advised to arrive early and watch the progression of classes for themselves. Exhibitors are responsible for being on time for their classes.
- 29) Numbers, together with a note of any changes to the timetable, will be forwarded to competitors prior to the show date. In the event that numbers have not been received three days before the show date, the Show Secretary should be contacted.

30) Condition of entry Class 7. To qualify for entry into this class the exhibitor must send in a copy of a Heritage Certificate which shows 75% or above Crabbet breeding and issued by the Crabbet Organisation or a letter from Caroline Sussex (Secretary) confirming that the horses entered have 75%+ Crabbet. If the Certificate states that the horse is under 75% Crabbet breeding or there is no letter the entry should be refused and returned to the exhibitor. (Any queries should be directed to Caroline Sussex by fax (01264 738133 or e-mail: Binleystud@aol.com).

31) Rules for showing Class 7. All horses forward **MUST** be shown in a natural manner. The pose must be natural, i.e. fore feet together and one hind leg slightly behind the other. The head should be held with the neck showing natural arch and curve of throat line, muzzle would be in line with a point around six – eight inches below the wither. The horse should be trained to stand quietly in this position with expression of interest in the handler. Any unnatural posing, flicking with a whip or circling when being run out, will result in the horse being judged as though no presentation or display had been possible and therefore penalised accordingly.

32) Any person or persons on the showground behaving in a rude, abusive or dangerous manner likely to compromise the health and safety and the enjoyment of anyone attending the show may be asked to leave the showground.

33) Any person or persons who are on the showground for any reason whatsoever, either before, during or after the show is deemed to have agreed to abide by the South East Arabian Horse Group Summer Show Rules and Conditions 2010.
